- Print - New or Used
 - Often available to rent
- Digital - eTexts and Courseware
 - Often multiple options for length of access (120 days, 180 days, purchase etc)

- Open Source Materials (*download for free!*)



Accessing Digital Materials

- Courseware often in Canvas 
 - During class enrollment: Dashboard
 - After class: Courses>All Courses & add 
- eTexts often in BryteWave:
 - Email link or brytewave.redshelf.com
 - Always use FSU email to set up account so books are together!
- Outside vendors: follow their instructions

FSU Inclusive Access Program

What is it?

A partnership between Student Business Services and the Bookstore to ensure student success by getting the right materials in their hands on or before the first day of classes at the lowest cost available.



FSU Inclusive Access Program

How does it work?

- Once you register for a participating class you will be automatically enrolled into the program.
- You will receive a set of emails from Student Business Services and the Bookstore welcoming you to the program and providing instructions on how to access your materials.
- You can use the link provided in the emails to opt-out of the program before the end of the opt-out portal window, which closes by the end of the second week of classes.
- If you drop the course before the opt-out portal closes two weeks after classes begin, a refund will be automatically processed. There is no need for you to do anything.



Inclusive Access: How to pay?

- Charges Automatically Show on FSU Invoice
 - Visible in SC to student and anyone they delegate with access to their financials
 - Pay by check via mail or in person [A1500 University Center or night drop box]
 - Pay electronically by e-check, credit card* or Western Union* [*fees apply]
