Students who qualify for High School Dual Enrollment (HSDE) at FSU may choose from courses on this list during registration if such courses are available at that time. This list does not constitute a promise of availability. Please note that course offerings vary by semester, so check Schedule Assistant or Class Search for availability. HSDE students may discuss other course options with their school counselor and ACE advisor.

Dual enrollment students may not take the following types of courses designated as excluded:

- Physical education, recreation, or leisure courses
- Any course offered for fewer than 3 credits, graded on a S/U basis, or offered as a directed individual study (DIS)
- Any course for which the student has not completed the prerequisite(s) established by the academic department(s)
- Any course for which a student has already earned or anticipates earning college credit (e.g., AP, IB, AICE, CLEP, or dual enrollment) or any course below a student's current level of proficiency based on a placement test (e.g., math and modern languages)
- Specialized admission, limited availability, honors, or major-restricted courses
- 4000-level courses except under limited special circumstances approved by FSU
- Online courses
- Other specialized courses designated as excluded from course offerings by FSU or the Florida Department of Education and communicated to students and school counselors at time of course registration

Although you may discuss other available courses (that are not restricted from HSDE) with your advisor, the following pages identify the recommended courses by general education or subject area. Courses highlighted in yellow are a part of the 15-hour statewide general education core, which make them ideal for students who plan to attend a public college or university in Florida.
